

# The Request List

6,050 as of March 9, 2011

- 2679 are under the age of 18.
- 3371 are age 18 or older.
- 15% have been on the list more than 5 years.
- 16% have been on list less than 1 year.

Next application date is May 18, 2004.

# Results: Demographic/Respondent Information

- The surveys were overwhelmingly answered by the applicants' mothers and fathers for both age groups (Under 18, 91.8%; 18 and Over 74.1%).
- Overall, the basic demographic information for the two age groups was very similar to each other and across DDSD Service Areas.

# Results: Age of Primary Caregiver

- The average age for the primary caregivers in the Under 18 age group was 42 years .(Range 23 – 75)
- The average age of the primary caregiver for individuals in the 18 and Over age group was 55 years. (Range 27-86)
- There were 64 primary caregivers in the 18 and Over group who were 65 or older,
- 15 primary caregivers were 65 or older in the Under 18 age group.

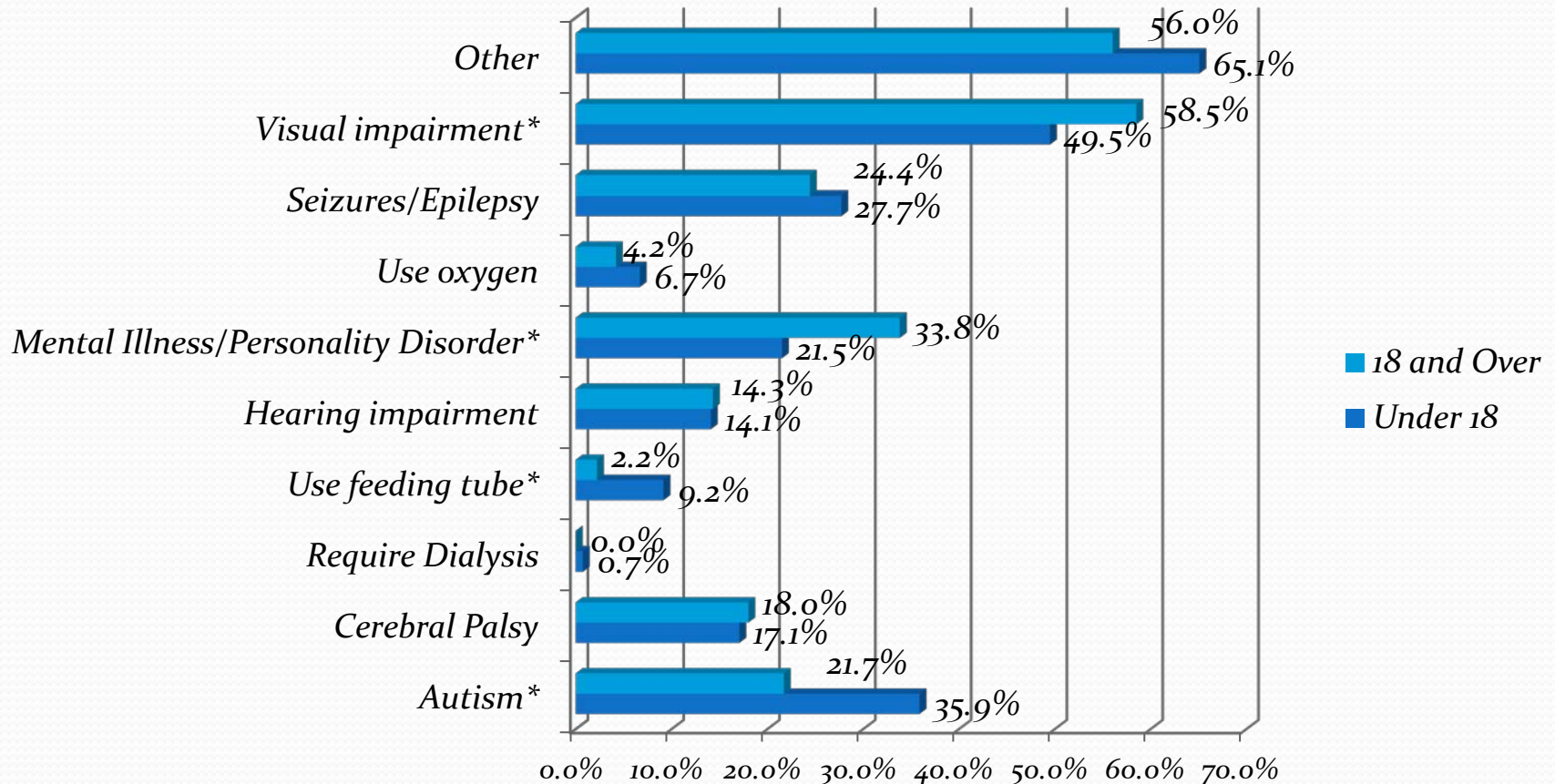
# Results: Primary Disability

Applicant *Diagnosed* with Intellectual Disability

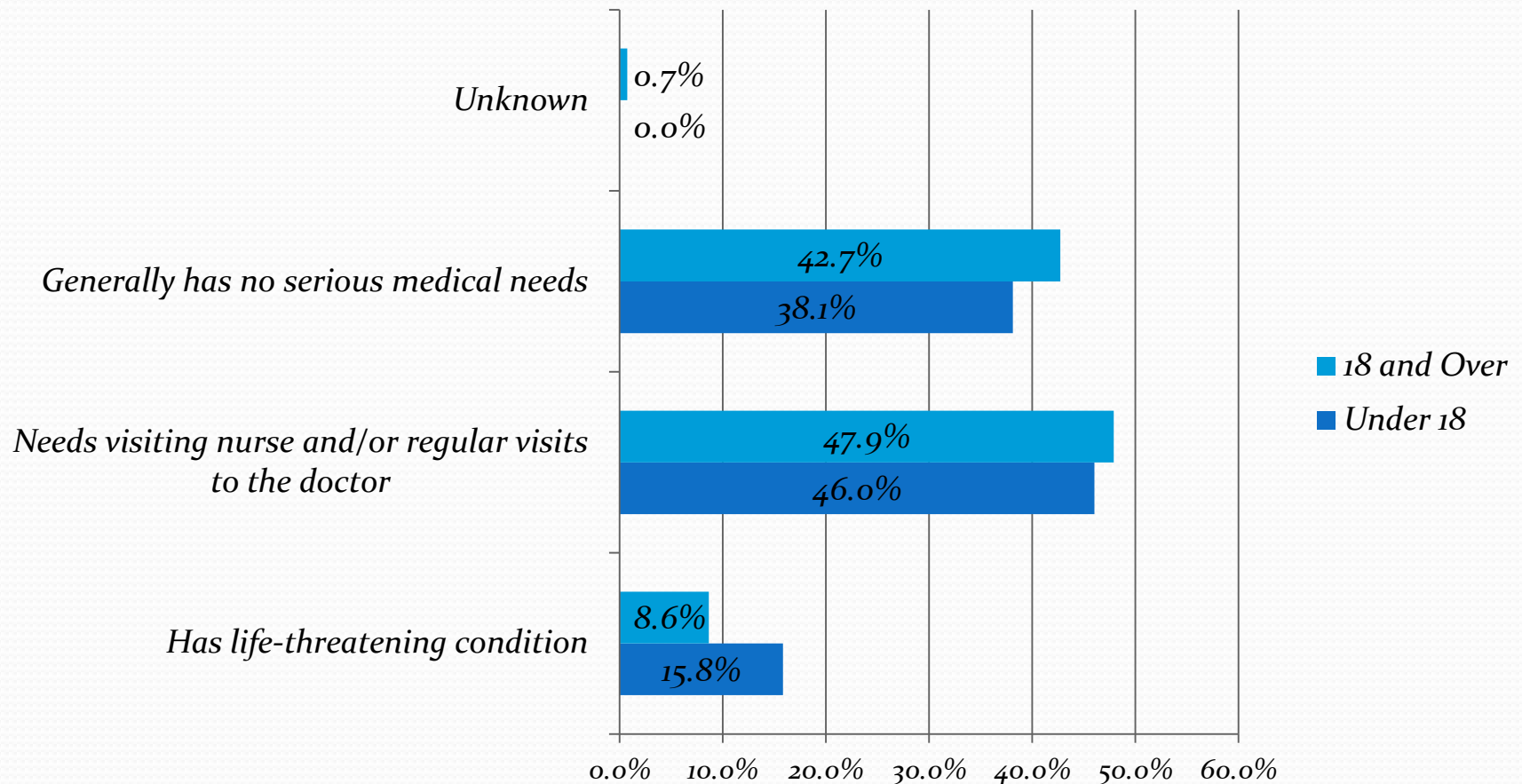
Yes – 71 %

# Results: Behavioral Issues

The survey asked three questions regarding behavioral issues...

- “Is this person a danger to himself/herself?”
- “Is this person a danger to others?”
- “Has this person had previous involvement with law enforcement?”

# Level of Danger

- Dangerous to Self
  - Under 18 Yes – 7.7%
  - 18 and Over Yes – 9.9%
- Dangerous to Others
  - Under 18 Yes – 5.9%
  - 18 and Over Yes – 3%



# Previous Involvement with Law Enforcement

- Under 18

Yes – 8.2%

- 18 and Over

Yes – 14.1%

# Results: Areas of Need and Levels of Assistance Needed

- The highest area of need for both age groups was assistance in **Daily Living Skills**.
  - 92.6% of applicants in the Under 18 age group reported needing assistance
  - 79% of applicants in the 18 and Over age group reported needing assistance
- Daily Living Skills include: training in dressing, bathing, eating, grooming, ambulation, money management, shopping, meal preparation, etc.

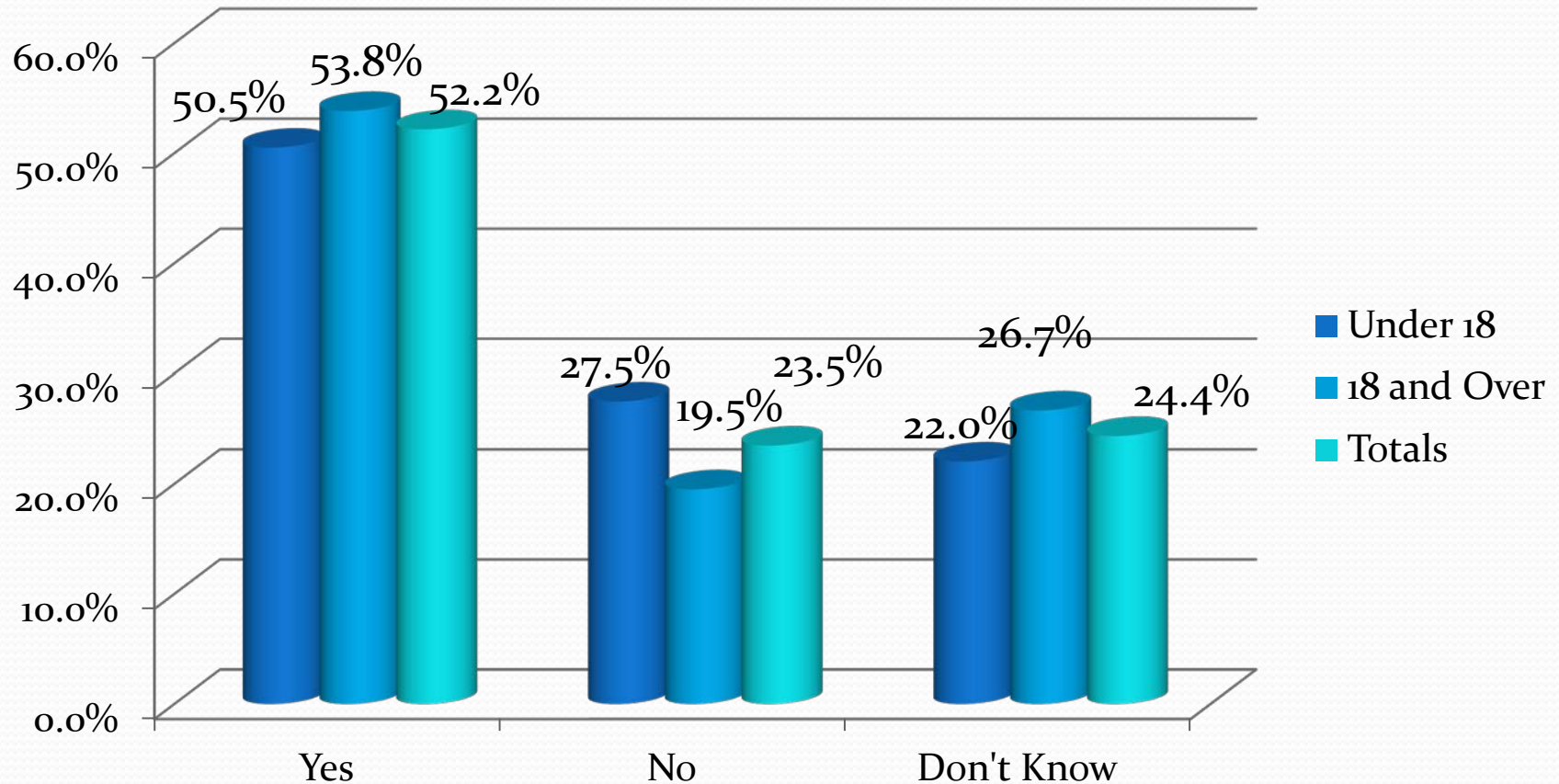
# Results: Service Needs and Priorities


- The service with the highest reported percentage of need for applicants in both age groups is **Case Management Services**
  - Under 18 age group - 68.3% need this service
  - 18 and Over age group - 74.8% of individuals need this service

# Services Reported as Urgently Needed

- Financial Assistance – 20%
- Case Management - 18%
- Minor Medical - 17.3%
- Vocational or Day Training – 15.9%
- Supports in Family Home – 14.5%
- Supports Outside Family Home – 10.3 %

# If available, would a \$250 monthly subsidy meet the needs of the applicant and/or the family? (By Age Group)



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- 52% of the total have income of \$30,000 or less.
    - Under 18 – 55.9%
    - 18 and Over – 48.6%
  - 27.6% of the total have income of \$15,000 or less.
    - Under 18 – 27.7%
    - 18 and Over – 27.6%
